

Against the background of discourses on social innovation and the (imperative) objectives of newness, organizational education perspectives inquire the changeability of organized systems as cultural and symbolic orders. Based on the following questions, the conference "Organization and Newness" aims at systematizing this unfolding field of research:

- Which demands for innovation objectives address organizations in educational fields? How is "the New" situated and positioned in discourses and institutions – and how can it be analyzed from the perspective of organizational education?
- What is the role of spaces and actors of change? How can modes of transformation be systematized in traditional institutions or developmental spaces, such as "innovation labs"?
- Which grammars of newness are fundamental to practices of organizational change, and which dynamics emerge in the negotiations of newness – for example in cooperative arrangements?
- How can organizational orders of the emergence of newness be reconstructed? Which methodological strategies and approaches prove to be productive for their empirical analysis?
- Which strategies of innovation and future creation are detectable in the field of Higher Education?
- What is the contribution of organizational education to the generation of strategies and practices of the New? How does organizational education conceptualize spaces of reflection and creation – and how does it enable them in the process of organizing?
